



## Play

Arrow Play is a performance sea kayak, developed specifically for, maneuvering & playing in the sea. It is also an excellent kayak for day trips or longer overnight getaways. The hull has significant rocker and volume in the bow to avoid diving when riding down a wave. The mid section has a slightly rounded profile making it very smooth from edge to edge. This combined with the hard chines make the play a joy to paddle whether you enjoy the rough stuff or just want a kayak that responds instantly to your moves. We have spent hundreds of hours with development, research and testing the Play model. In the past four years the Play has proven to be a very popular kayak all over Scandinavia.

### New for 2013:

We have redesigned the deck and bow making the deck look smoother with softer lines, especially the front deck has a lower appearance and will catch less wind. The deck line outfitting has been made more practical and the overhang in the bow has been lowered and extended. The key selling point for the Play is versatility; it fits a wide range of paddlers in almost all skill levels. It is stable without sacrificing maneuverability and speed.
